

Dr. Khademhosseini, Junior PI, was awarded "Presidential Early Career Award for Scientists and Engineers (PECASE)*" from the White House.

President Obama today named 94 researchers including Dr. Khademhosseini as recipients of the Presidential Early Career Awards for Scientists and Engineers, the highest honor bestowed by the United States government on science and engineering professionals in the early stages of their independent research careers.

AIMR appointed Dr. Khademhosseini as Junior PI in 2009. Since then Dr. Khademhosseini has been working as a leader of his laboratory at AIMR, fostering young researchers of his laboratory, and also he has been dedicated to promoting Fusion Research.
